Program

Fellow Elmhurst Rotarian Curt Linson provided us an action-packed slide show of his last six months living in the Philippine Islands. Greg typically spends six months there and six months in the US. Those who have experienced the Philippines know that there are only two seasons, the Rainy season and the Dry season. Think frequent tropical rainstorms and you will understand why Curt likes to be in the Midwest for six months of the year.

A native of the Phillipines, Curt's wife Nancy has extended family on the island of Luzon and as the family matriarch, is very active in their lives. Located north of Manilla (and Manilla Bay) in the San Fernando area, Curt and Nancy recently built a spacious new home in a gorgeous setting. Views of a rice paddy on one side, where three rice crops a year are harvested, is complimented on the other side with a distant view of Mount Arayat.

Curt attends the Rotary Club of San Fernando where most members speak English as well as their native Tagalog. Curt does not claim to speak Tagalog but has no doubt picked up a good bit just by listening.

How did an American from Indiana end up in Southeast Asia (SEA)? Essentially, Curt's job with a reseller of food packaging equipment sent him to various locations in the area, including Kuala Lumpur.

Much of SEA does not enjoy reliable electric service to keep fruits and vegetables from spoiling in that tropical climate. Curt's compony sold machinery for making containers that are very tightly sealed (think how long a jar of strawberry jam or other fruit would last without being airtight and, once opened, kept refrigerator cold.) Such boxes preserve many food items like mangos and pineapples that are in high demand locally.

Curt was previously an Elmhurst Rotarian but found his job did not allow him to be as active as much as he wanted. He resigned from the club but after retirement last year has rejoined us and now has more time for Rotary. (In addition to the weather, having access to major league baseball is another reason for Curt's sixmonth rotation.) Thanks, Curt, for a fine program!
